Complaints concerning disturbance

Showing consideration to other residents, complying with the rules of the housing company and taking care of the shared facilities are prerequisites for an enjoyable place to live. No one may disturb others' with their behaviour or unnecessarily otherwise disturb others' peaceful living.

If you do find that you are being disturbed in your home, you should first try to resolve the situation by talking to the person who is disturbing you. You can also discuss about the matter with your other neighbours and perhaps talk together to the person who is disturbing you.

If the disturbances are serious and frequent, you can make a written complaint by using this form. It is recommended to write the complaint together with your neighbours to get a wider view of the situation. Send the complaint by post to HOAS, PL 799, 00101 HELSINKI or as email attachment to tenantsupport@hoas.fi.

Your complaint will be investigated and the other party will be asked to give their view on the matter, after which procedures stipulated in the Tenancy Act will follow. Your complaint will always be handled confidentially. If you sign the complaint you must be prepared to appear in court as a witness if necessary.
